Vaccination is the **ONLY** way to prevent it.


Why Vaccination Matters:

Understanding Immunity: Immunity means having protection against a disease. For measles, this is typically achieved through vaccination. When enough people are immune, it helps protect those who cannot be vaccinated.

Who is Most at Risk?

- Unvaccinated individuals
- Babies under 12 months old
- Pregnant women
- Immunocompromised individuals
- Healthcare workers



Up to **9 in 10** people who lack immunity to measles and are close to an infected person will become infected
